~I am bringing this issue to the attention of the trustees in an effort to not only be a good steward of my own land but to also be a good neighbor, in hopes of avoiding someone coming into contact with the poisonous effects of these dangerous weeds that are being allowed to grow not only in our township but throughout our county and many others.

~I have researched some of these plants that are more prevalent in our area and struggle to keep them off of my land because they can be deadly to humans, livestock, and pets. It is an ongoing task when these noxious weeds grow out of control all around you.

~ Simply breathing the pollen can damage the lungs.

~My own parents have experienced the harmful effects of breathing the pollen from poison hemlock (growing in the neighbor's pasture) and had to remain indoors in a controlled environment especially when the wind blew from west to east delivering the pollen onto our property.

~my dad reached out to a township trustee last summer and was told that he would definitely take care of the problem (poison hemlock growing higher than the fence top) by asking our neighbor to mow down the weeds. Someone came in and mowed a few passes along the fence but the rest of it was not mowed until later in the summer.
