ODOT estimated \$600,000 for work of a buried pipe and land acquisition. There was a suggestion of having the water run to the creek to prevent flooding. 

Attached are the files associated with the drainage elevations along US127 in your respected township / village. As suspected, we currently do not have what we feel is adequate elevations allowing us to "re-route" the current flow and send it to the north channel. A portion of that drainage ditch is within the village limits and therefore the village has jurisdictional rights over that portion *as well as* the liability for any issues a change of direction may cause if you choose to do so.


